## 1. Vacancy for Research Intern: New Irish Emigration

Emigration of Irish nationals increased by more than 50% in the twelve months to April 2010 from 18,400 to 27,700, and it is expected that the 2011 figures will reflect another increase. It is estimated that approximately **one third of Irish nationals leaving Ireland have emigrated to the UK.**

Crosscare Migrant Project is looking for an intern **to research this new wave of Irish emigration to the UK.** The primary role of the intern will be to gather and document current information on the **numbers, profile and experiences** of these recent emigrants to the UK, and to engage effectively with agencies working with Irish emigrants or potential emigrants both in Ireland and in the UK.

The internship will be for 3 months full-time or six months part-time. This is an unpaid position; however reasonable travel costs and lunch expenses will be reimbursed. **Closing date for applications is Friday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2011.**

## 2. Launch of a new Internship Placement Service for Irish citizens in the United States

The Irish International Immigrant Centre in Boston has launched a new **Internship Placement Service for Irish students and graduates** who participate in the Intern Work & Travel (IWT) Programme in the United States.

The Intern Work & Travel (IWT) Programme is a scheme that allows Irish citizen **students and recent graduates** to participate in internships to **work in their field of study in the United States** for a period of **up to 12 months.** Students or graduates who submit their application for the IWT Programme through the Irish International Immigrant Centre in Boston can avail of the Internship Placement Service at **no extra cost.**

The placement service seeks to **match participants with appropriate employers,** and will **help participants to find internships** in any part of the United States.
